### \_\_\_\_\_ **Garden**

- Plan the garden: obtain/purchase seeds, layout, rotation
- Prepare beds for planting: compost, soil, fertilizer, stepping stones, etc.
- Greenhouses: seed, repot, transplant
- Grow: plant, water, fertilize, pest control, weed beds, row cover
- Harvest: weekly, take produce to food banks

### \_\_\_\_\_ **Maintenance**

- Build and/or repair of structures, fence, beds, greenhouses
- Maintain perimeter: wood chips, invasive plants, shed, beds, flower "bed"
- Weed garden: paths, around office, flowers, shelter, perimeter
- Maintain irrigation system
- Hose maintenance: replace/repair, store for winter
- Paint
- Prepare beds for planting w/Garden group

### \_\_\_\_\_ **Outreach**

- Events: plan, host, set up, clean up
- Farmers Market booth: set up, man booth, tear down
- Host large volunteer groups eg. Boeing, Kiwanis, United Way
- Monitor educational programs: Saturday classes, tours
- Fundraising/Advocacy
